

Magical Mandalas

Instructions



1. Design your mandala.
You can use my designs or design your own by hand or by using this handy online tool:
<https://www.staedtler.com/intl/en/mandala-creator/>
2. If you are working on a large scale, as a group piece, you could use cardboard or recycled paper for each shape and cover them with recycled materials before you assemble them.
3. If you are working on a small scale you could cut the individual shapes out of recycled materials and stick them on your design. Each layer of the mandala could have a different colour or theme to help distinguish them.
4. Take a photograph of your completed mandala.
5. If you are happy to appear on our website or social media channels, you can also send a second photograph of you or your class with your mandala.
6. Send the photographs to me at caroline.fish@suffolk.gov.uk as soon as they are ready and no later than **18 December**. Let me know which school you are from!
7. Use your mandala as a display in your classroom or hang them at home as a decoration at Christmas to spread the message that we are all connected and want to look after each other and the environment!
